Objective No2 .- The representation had to be simple, using only geometrical figures, and understandable in its expression to everyone

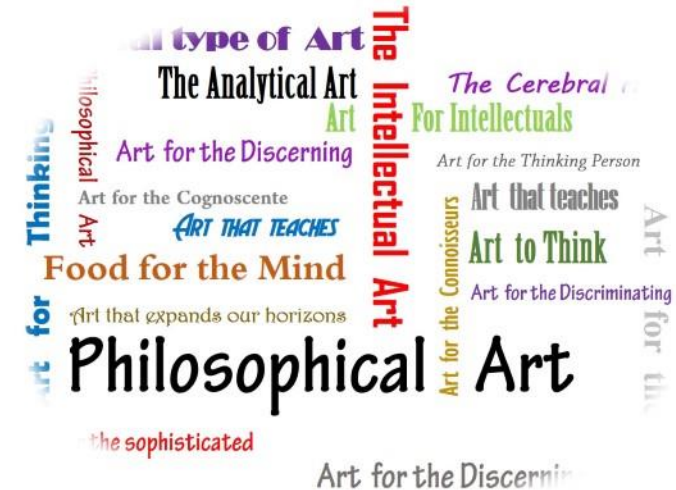
Objective No 3 .- It had to be based on the definition of the term or concept, It had to reflect in the most accurate way possible the specific meaning of the concept.

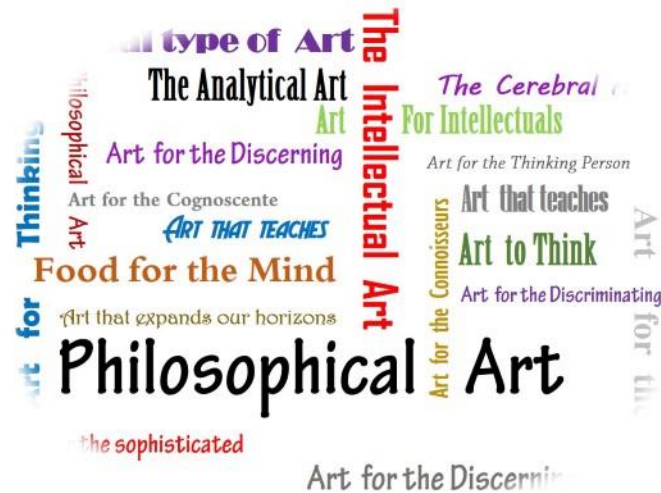

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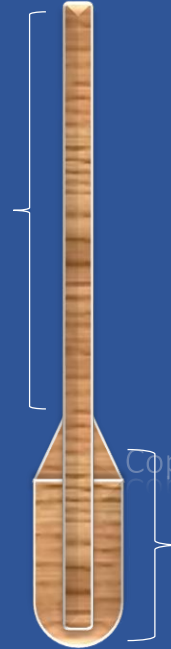
